Blue Funnel Three Rivers Cruise from Town Quay Southampton



What to expect Train to Southampton, bus down to Town Quay and then a 3 hour Blue Funnel Cruise into the Solent visiting the Itchen, Test and Hamble Rivers plus on board Fish & Chips! It's a bit early but it looks as if Queen Mary 2 may be there

The cruise boards at Town Quay at Southampton at 1205. We need to be at Town Quay at 1145.

Getting there As the party will be quite large and travelling down together could be a bit tricky - as we might not all get on the Quay Connect bus together at Southampton Central. This runs every 30 minutes I suggest that, as we have done before, we meet on the quayside.

The rail time table for July is not yet available but the current 0919 departure from Goring gets to Southampton at 1043, the 0946 at 1117. Quay Connect bus at 1100 and 1130 (takes 7 minutes)

In all cases change at Reading for the next Cross Country Voyager for Southampton (direct)

Return Catch the next fast train to Reading when you get back to Southampton Central.

Costs The rail fare with card is £18.05. Bus fare is £2 return if bus passes are not accepted. Cruise fare is £22.95

Food and drink Included in cruise.
