What to expect?

An introductory talk, followed by a guided tour of the Museum. The Museum covers the evolution of aircraft at Farnborough through balloons, airships and kites to aircraft. It covers the development of aircraft including supersonic research and vertical take-off flight, and the development of jet engines. There is also a section on Samuel Cody, who developed a family of aeroplanes at Farnborough. Anyone interested in aviation would find this a fascinating place to visit; those not into aeroplanes may be better not going on this trip.

COST: Rail fares (£6.25 with Senior Railcard), plus £10 entrance per member. A minimum number of 10 members is required.
